Merry Christmas and Happy New Year....

Good to see many of you at the 5:30 Christmas Eve Service. Attendance increased significantly this year, and it was indeed a wonderful celebration of the Hope, Peace, Joy and Love of Christ! Greetings of old friends, family reunions, soaring voices and melodious instruments all added to the spirit!

So what now? One song played on flute and piano was the Charlie Brown song "Christmas Time is Here." The unsung lyrics end with the words "Oh that we could always see such spirit THROUGH THE YEAR." This theme has echoes everywhere, perhaps the most famous being the poem by Howard Thurman called "Then the Work of Christmas Begins." when the kings and princes are home, when the shepherds are back with the flocks,


the work of Christmas begins:




